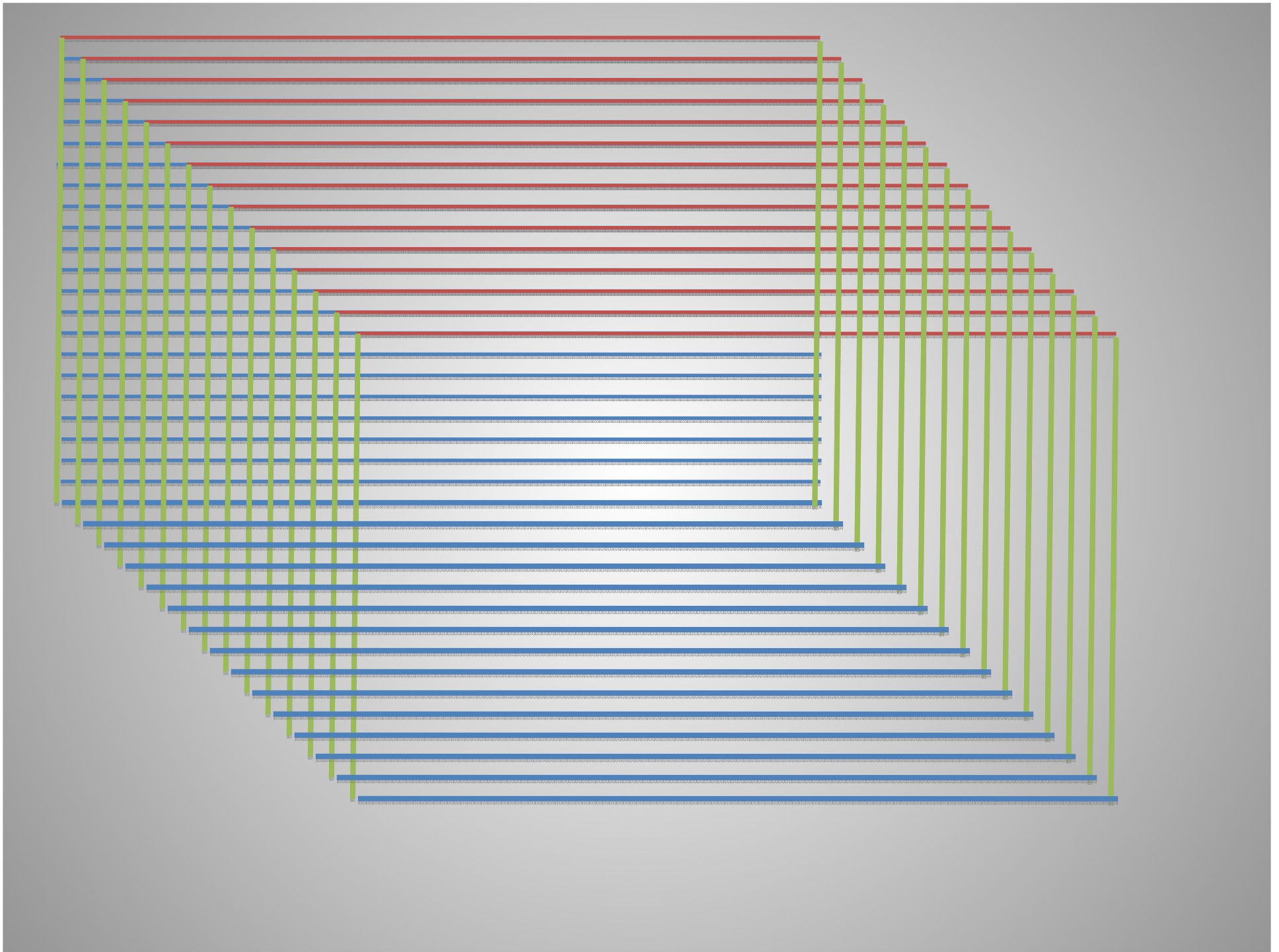

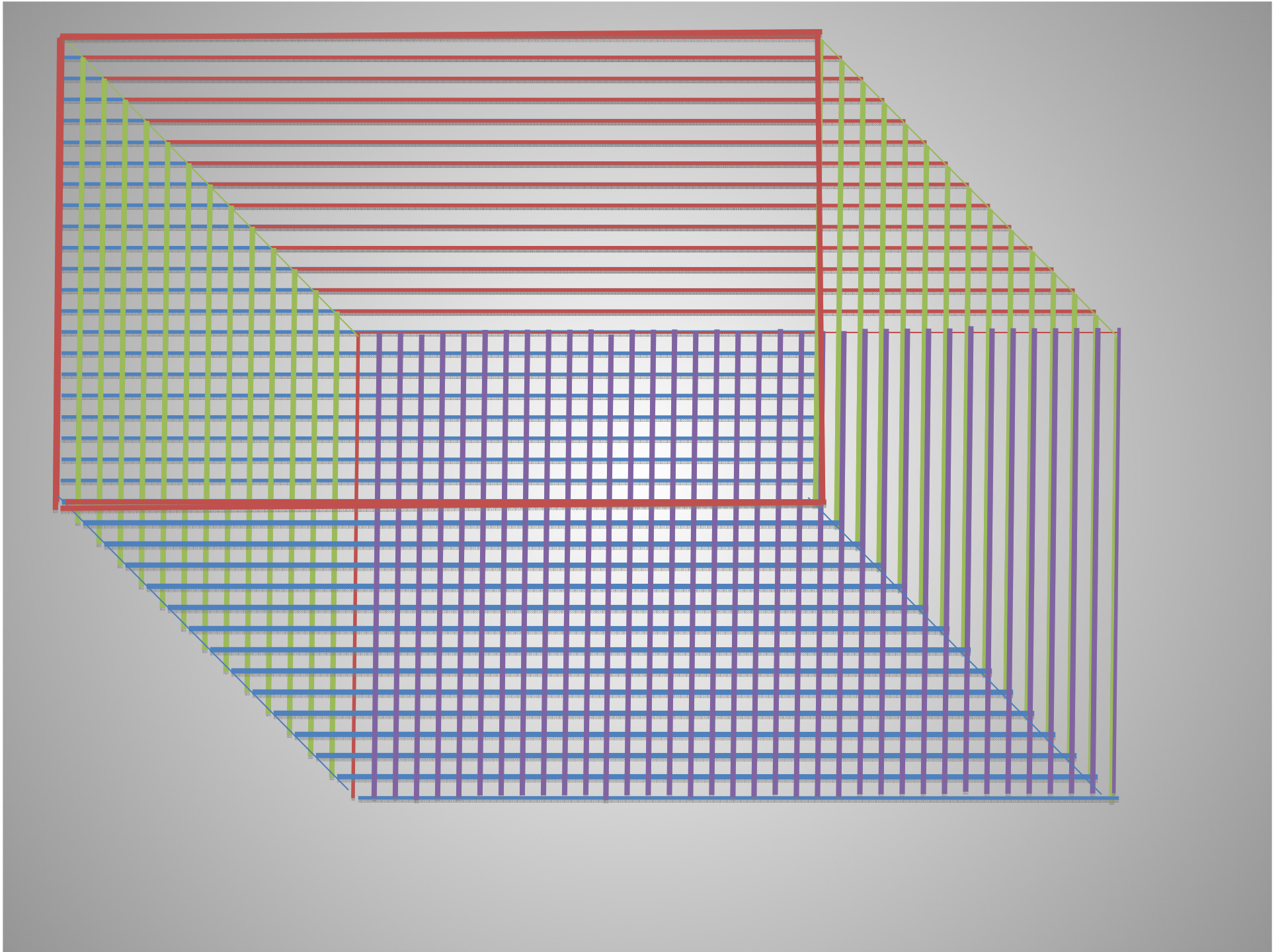


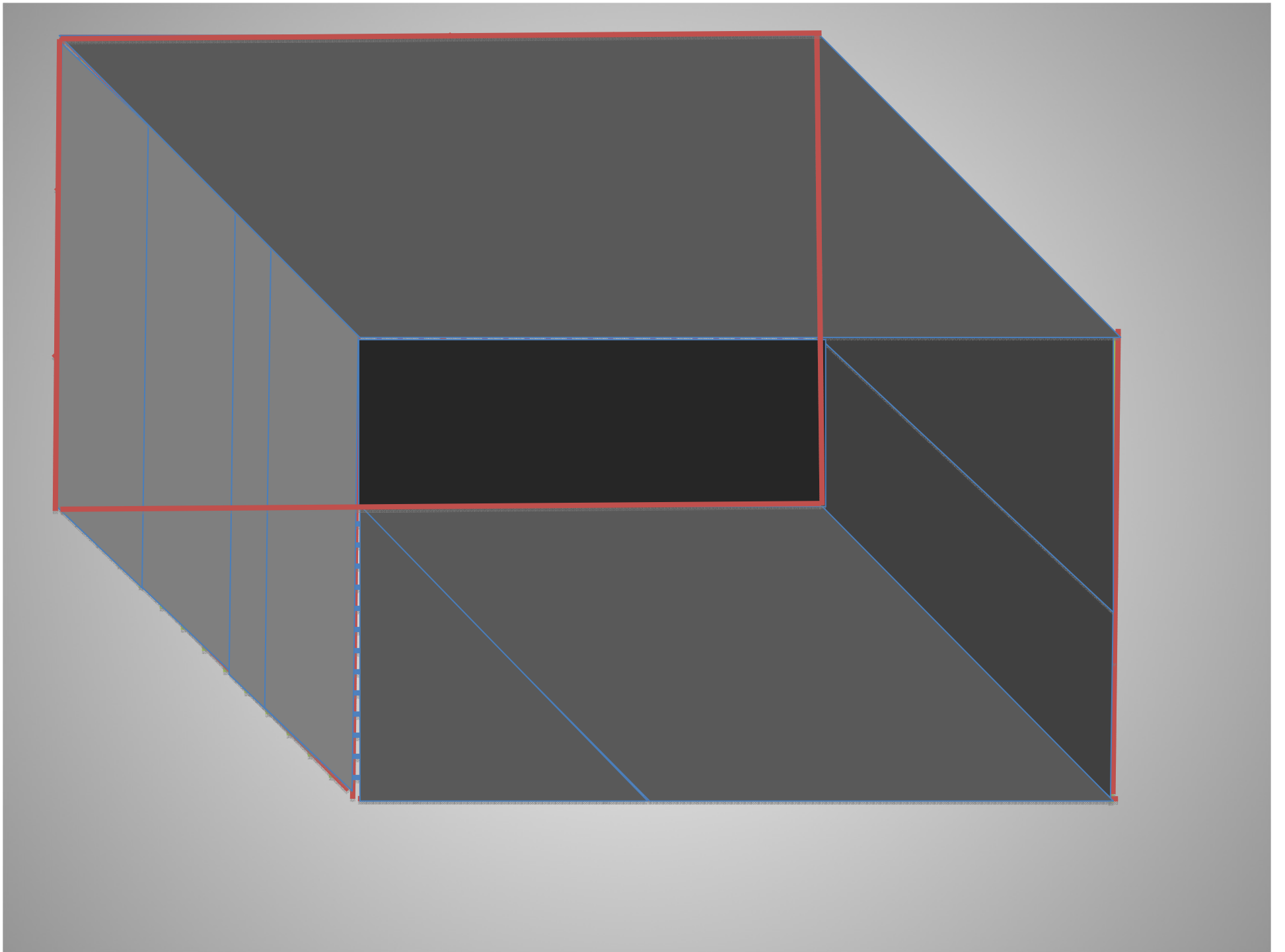
Security perception

- Over the past decade a constructive tension has emerged in the security profession as these perceptions are challenged

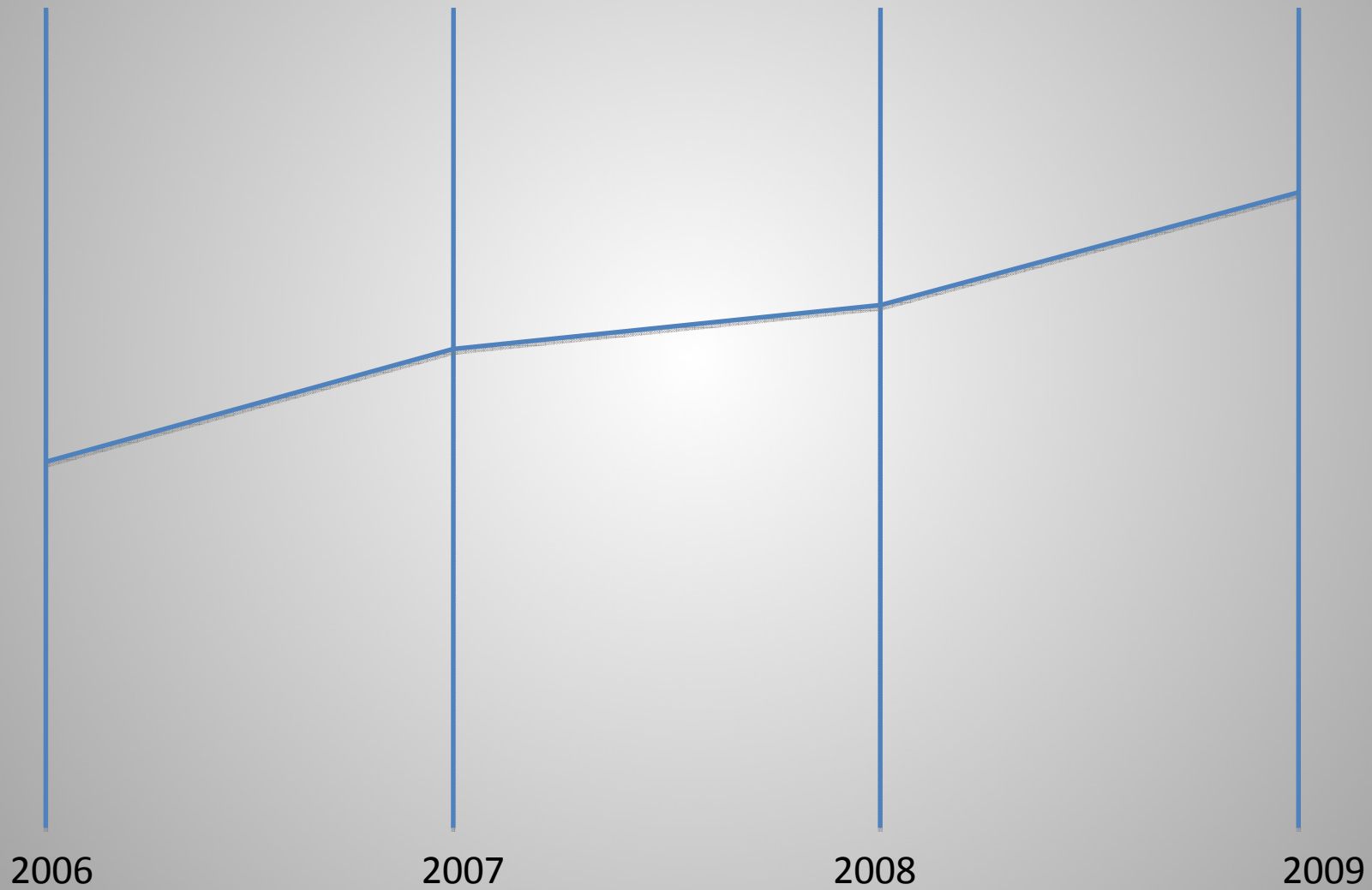
